

Minneapolis On-Street Bikeways

Bike Lanes

On maps:



Exclusive space for bicyclists. Motor vehicles may cross lanes to park, turn into a driveway or to make a turn. Parking in a bike lane is prohibited.

Busier streets – bikes ride next to moving motor vehicle traffic and parked cars.

White bike lane symbols and white lines define the lanes. Dashed lines near intersections and bus stops show mixing zones between bikes and motor vehicles.

Marked Shared Lanes

On maps:



Shared between motor vehicles and bicyclists. Motor vehicles may drive over the shared lane symbols.

Streets with moderate vehicle traffic that are too narrow for bike lanes.

White shared lane symbols identify a safe place for bicyclists to ride outside of the “Door Zone” (see left).

Bike Boulevards

On maps:



Shared between motor vehicles and bicyclists. Motor vehicles may drive over the bike boulevard symbols.

Usually on **low-traffic streets** that are too narrow for bike lanes.

Large, white bike boulevard symbols direct bicyclists to ride in the middle of the lane.
