Exhibitions and Temporary Markets/Flea Markets

With a changing business climate, the City of Minneapolis is expanding the types of retail opportunities for Minneapolis residents and visitors which promote recycled, vintage and collectible markets and contribute to sustainable lifestyles and economic growth.

Exhibitions and Temporary Markets /Flea Markets will be licensed by the City of Minneapolis and overseen by a manager who will be responsible for the supervision, management and control of that market.

License requirements and applications can be obtained on our website at:

Markets must meet Zoning requirements. Call 311 or 612.673.3000.

- Site plan approval will be required and includes parking, trash removal and toilets.
- Hours of operation will be limited to 6AM-10PM unless an extended hour's license has been obtained.
- Vendors are prohibited from purchasing items at the market.

Goods sold by vendors in the temporary market include but are not limited to:

- Arts and Crafts
- Second Hand Goods
- Precious metals and jewelry
- Agricultural goods and food products (limited to 25% of vendors with a maximum of 10)

Restrictions on the types of goods sold include but are not limited to:

- Electronics including used cell phones
- Drug paraphernalia
- Hazardous materials
- Weapons
- Alcoholic beverages
- New merchandise
