Description:

Approving acceptance of the federal Certified Local Government (CLG) grant to:

1. Conduct designation studies and prepare design guidelines for properties associated with the historically significant secular contributions of religious institutions, and
2. Appropriate CPED-Development Services Division budget funds, increasing the Revenue Budget for the Community Planning and Economic Development Agency federal fund (01300) by \$20,000.

Background/Analysis:

The grant funds will provide resources to conduct designation studies and prepare design guidelines for properties associated with the historically significant secular contributions of religious institutions. The Certified Local Government (CLG) grant is a federal grant administrated through the Minnesota State Historical Preservation Office of the Minnesota Historical Society. Since 1983, as a Certified Local Government, the City of Minneapolis has been eligible to apply for, and has received grants for projects such as context statements, landmark designations, and historic resource surveys.
